Aaron Venouziou, MD was born in Thessaloniki (Greece). He is a graduate of the University of Thessaly School of Medicine in Larissa. He completed a residency in Orthopaedic Surgery at the University Hospital of Larissa. Then, he went on an advanced training in Hand, Upper Extremity Surgery and Microsurgery at Allegheny General Hospital, Drexel University in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania for 2 years (2009-2011). Dr. Venouziou has 21 published papers and abstracts in peer reviewed scientific journals, 5 book chapters in orthopaedic textbooks, and several presentations in Greek and International scientific meetings. He has also won several national awards and grants. Dr. Venouziou is an active member of the Hellenic Society of Hand and Upper Extremity Surgery, the Hellenic Society of Reconstructive Microsurgery, the Hellenic Society of Arthroscopic Surgery and the Hellenic Orthopaedic Association. His clinical emphasis is in shoulder, elbow, wrist and hand surgery, including arthroscopy and joint replacement (total and reverse shoulder arthroplasty), as well as repair of the tendon, ligament, and nerve and fracture care.
